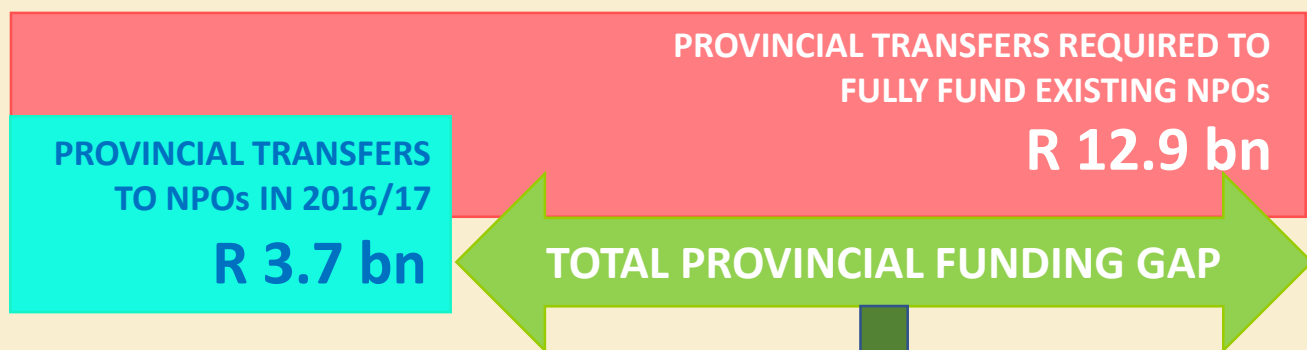


COST IMPLICATIONS OF THE NAWONGO COURT JUDGEMENTS

IN TRANSFERS TO EXISTING NPOs

ACTIONS

- 1 Develop a strategy to prioritise the funding of social welfare services
- 2 Put in place an NPO funding policy aligned to the NAWONGO judgements
- 3 Put in place service funding standards for “core items” at reasonable unit costs
- 4 Put in place standard names and definitions for welfare services so that expenditure can be reported credibly
- 5 Put in place routine processes for gathering information on welfare services provided by both provincial DSDs and NPOs
