Clarification Question 3:

In the work plan, you have specified the estimated level of effort as 39.5 days in total. Does that mean the 39.5 days are spread across the entire team or can a company use a team that will work on the project for the 39.5 days? Examples are provided below based on the work plan provided on page 6 of the “Terms of Reference”

Phase	Item	Week	Estimated level of effort (days)	Question
1.1	Participate in feasibility planning workshop	1	0.5	Is one individual required for 0.5 days or can we have a team that will be allocated 0.5 days for this item
1.2	Receive and review preliminary resources	1	3	Is one individual required for 3 days or can we have a team that will be allocated 3 days for this item

Response to Question 3:

The level of effort is indicative and teams can propose more days than that. For example, some activities like 1.1 would benefit from the attendance of more than 1 team member. Similarly, activity 1.2 could also benefit from the involvement of more than 1 team member. However, other activities will predominately use one person.
